Dear Parents / Guardians

A warm welcome to all our parents and learners, and best wishes for 2026.

The following information is **very important** and we suggest that you keep it in a safe place, as it will save you unnecessary telephone calls to the school.

FRIDAYS THE SCHOOL CLOSSES AT 13:15 FOR GR 1-6 & RESOURCE CLASS.

On the last day, when school closes for the term, all learners will be dismissed at 11:00.

Parents are requested to fetch learners promptly. Under no circumstances are learners allowed to remain unsupervised on the school premises or pavements after school.

SCHOOL FEES

At a budget meeting held on 16 October 2025 it was decided to increase the fees to **R16 280 per year per learner**. Full annual payments made before **28 February 2026** will qualify for a **5% discount**. The amount of **R16 280** may also be paid in eleven instalments. Payments must be made from **January to November 2026** at **R1480 per month**.

Exemption of School fees: If you need an appointment with the principal, you must book at the office during January 2026. Appointments will take place as from Monday, 26 January 2026. All applications will close on Friday, 27 February 2026.

SCHOOL BAG

All learners must have a **sturdy** school bag in bottle green or black in colour. Bags with wheels are NOT allowed as they cause damage to our floors. No other bag colours will be permitted.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

We expect that all learners to be dressed according to the Code of Conduct. A learner who respects his/her school uniform also shows respect for the school. Clean and neat school uniform contributes to discipline and good behaviour. If a learner does not wear the correct school uniform, a letter will be issued from the office.
